CAL POLY POMONA STUDENT LAPTOP PAYMENT PLAN

What is the Student Laptop Program?

The Student Laptop Program makes it easier for Cal Poly Pomona students to purchase a computer or tablet through Bronco Tech. Students may finance an eligible device by paying 25% upfront, with the remaining balance divided into 11 monthly payments billed through BroncoDirect. The program can be used for in-stock devices or special orders, and there are no interest charges. Students may also purchase the device in full instead of using the payment plan.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. **Can I use financial aid to pay for my laptop?**
 - Yes. Financial aid can be used. With the payment plan, each payment is billed to your student account and available financial aid may be applied. Arrangements must be made through the Bookstore.
2. **Can I use Bronco Bucks to pay for my laptop?**
 - Yes, but arrangements must be made through the Bookstore.
3. **Can I switch my laptop later to a newer or better one?**
 - No. Students remain responsible for payments on the selected laptop until the payment plan ends or the balance is paid in full.
4. **If I switch majors and need a more powerful laptop, can I exchange my laptop?**
 - No. Consider a higher-performance laptop if your needs may change. Once opened, devices are not eligible for return/exchange.
5. **What if I do not want to be in the program anymore? Can I get a full refund?**
 - Refunds are overseen case by case. Contact the Bookstore at studentlaptops@cpp.edu.
6. **What happens if my laptop is lost or stolen?**
 - You are still responsible for paying the device in full. A new device agreement cannot begin until any previous agreement is paid in full.
7. **Am I liable if my laptop gets compromised through malware/viruses/hackers, etc.?**
 - Users are responsible for maintenance and care of their machines, including software, hardware, virus detection, and malware protection.
8. **Can I buy any laptop in this program in one upfront payment?**
 - Yes. All laptops offered through the program may be purchased outright instead of using the payment plan.
9. **Is the laptop strictly for educational use while I am making payments?**
 - No. The laptop is yours to use as you prefer while payments are current. Any return before the plan ends is subject to Bookstore discretion.
10. **What happens if I stop going or transfer from CPP?**
 - You are still responsible for paying the device in full.
11. **Can I have my laptop shipped to my home or parents' home?**
 - Yes, but arrangements must be made through the Bookstore.
12. **What happens if I miss a payment? Are there late fees?**
 - Missed payments place a financial hold on your records until payments are current. Holds may limit future enrollment and/or receipt of your diploma.
13. **Do we get charged interest?**
 - No. The offered price is all-inclusive with no additional interest charges.
14. **Are there other student offers/deals on tech besides this program?**
 - Sometimes. Check with Bronco Tech associates for the latest offers.
15. **When will I own this laptop?**
 - Students own their laptops once all outstanding payments have been made in full.
